Stampin' Up Supplies Used:

- Golden Honey Specialty Designer Series Paper (SAB free 152311)
- Gold Foil Sheets (132622)
- Basic Black Cardstock (121045)
- Detailed Bees Dies (151526)
- 3/8" Metallic-Edge Ribbon, Gold (144146)
- Dark Black Stampin' Blend (147941)
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)

Other Supplies Used:

- 1 1/2" Clip (Gold or Black)
- Chipboard from package of DSP
- RSVP Pen

- Mini notepad
- Mini Composition notebook

Measurements:

- Chipboard: 4" x 6"
- Golden Honey Specialty DSP:
 - For clipboard: 2 pieces 4" x 6"
 - For binder clip: 1 piece 1 1/4" x 1 7/8"
 - For mini notepad top: 1 piece 2" x 2 1/4"
 - For mini composition notebook: 2 pieces 2 3/4" x 4 1/2"
 - For inside pen: 1 piece 1" x 3 1/2"
- Gold Foil:
 - For clipboard: 2 pieces 4" x 1/4"
 - For mini composition notebook: 2 pieces 4 1/2" x 1/4", 2 pieces 2 3/4" x 1/4"
 - Two pieces of scraps for bumblee
- Basic Black Cardstock:
 - For clipboard: 4" x 2 1/4"
 - For mini composition notebook: 2 3/4" x 1 3/4"

Instructions:

To make the clipboard, adhere the 4" x 6" pieces of DSP to each side of the chipboard with Multipurpose glue. Decide which side will be the front, then adhere the 1/4" x 4" gold strips and 4" x 2 1/4" piece of Basic Black cardstock to the bottom. Cut out large bumblebee from the Detailed Bees Dies from a scrap of Gold Foil and adhere to bottom of black.

Adhere the 1 1/4" x 1 7/8" piece of DSP to binder clip with Multipurpose glue. Wrap it around and hold down until it dries. Do the same with the 2" x 2 1/4" piece of DSP to the top of the mini notepad.

Color the white ribbon with the Dark Black Stampin' Blend.

Attach mini notepad to top of clipboard with binder clip. Flip front handle down and back handle up. Tie ribbon to back handle.

To decorate the pen, unscrew the cap and remove the end. Roll the 1" x 3 1/2" piece of DSP tightly and insert into empty barrel. Insert pen and screw cap back on.



Cover the front and the back of the mini composition notebook with a strip of Gold Foil and DSP. Trim the corners. Adhere the shorter Gold Foil strips to the Basic Black piece, then adhere to center of the front. Cut out a gold bumblebee using the Detailed Bees Dies and adhere to center of black piece.

This is a quick and easy way to use up your DSP scraps. Enjoy!
